On June 7th our Manchester office was delighted to host a visit from the International Visitor Leadership Program that was coordinated by the World Affairs Council of New Hampshire. Representatives from Cameroon, Japan, Madagascar, Nigeria, Somalia, Thailand, Tunisia and Zambia spent that afternoon with Hampshire First Bank President and CEO Jim Dunphy. Each year, the **International Visitor Leadership Program** brings about 4,500 visitors to the US for observational study tours from a few days to three weeks in duration. The program is administered as a partnership between the US Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, Office of International Visitors, and private sector partners in Washington and cities around the US. The World Learning Visitor Exchange Program, and its predecessor Delphi International, have been developing these programs for over 25 years.
